

## List of Native Plantings in Lyme Pollinator Meadows

### Pollinator Meadow on Town of Lyme Campus

The pollinator garden was started by broadcasting seeds from *Harts Northeast Wildflower Mix* over the “grassy meadows” in 2016. The seed mix is 60% annual and 40% perennial.

Subsequent Live plantings are chosen to have blooms at different times of the season to provide longer food sources for pollinators.

#### These live plants were added 2017 to 2019:

*Asclepias syriaca* - Common milkweed (summer bloom)

*Asclepias tuberosa* - Butterfly Weed (summer bloom)

*Coreopsis lanceolata* - Lance-leaf Coreopsis (spring-summer bloom)

*Helenium autumnale* - Sneezeweed. (late summer bloom)

*Monarda fistulosa* - Bee Balm, Wild Bergamot (summer bloom)

*Symphotrichum novae-angliae* - New England Aster (fall bloom)

*Schizachyrium scoparium* - Little Bluestem

*Solidago* - Goldenrod (fall bloom)

*Trifoliate hybrid unit* - Alsike clover

**May 2020:** planted 1 Dogwood on North boundary

*Agastache foeniculum* - Anise Hyssop (summer bloom)

*Baptisia Australis*-False Blue Indigo (spring bloom)

*Silene regia*-Royal Catchfly (Summer Bloom)

*Symphotrichum oblongifolium*-Aromatic Aster (fall bloom)

*Zizia aurea*-Golden Alexander (spring bloom)

**May 2021 :**

*Amsonia salicifolia* - Bluestar (spring bloom)

*Penstemon digitalis* Foxglove Beardtongue (spring/summer bloom)

*Pycnanthemum tenuifolium* - Mountain Mint (summer bloom)

*Zizia aurea* - Golden Alexander (spring bloom)

### Riverside Preserve Pollinator Meadow: Live native plants were planted June 5, 2021

*Asclepias syriaca* - Common Milkweed

*Asclepias tuberosa* - Butterfly Milkweed

*Asclepias purpurascens* - Purple Milkweed

*Asclepias incarnata* - Swamp Milkweed

*Eutrochium maculatum* - Joe-Pye weed

*Eupatorium spp.* - Boneset

*Vernonia noveboracensis* - New York Ironweed

*Pycnanthemum muticum* - Clustered Mountain Mint

*Veronicastrum virginicum* - Culver's root

*Rudbeckia laciniata* - Green-headed Coneflower
